The 2004 version of this Solomon Hills pinot noir brought us more queries about its availability than any wine in recent memory, and this 2005 is even better. Not to be missed!

"Tolmach's 2005 Pinot Noir Solomon Hills comes from a parcel planted with Dijon clones 667 and 777. Its deep ruby/purple color is followed by loads of sweet cherry, blackberry, and currant fruit interwoven with notions of forest floor, oak, and earth.
