

2017 PINOT NOIR PUERTA DEL MAR SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

Coming from a super-coastal vineyard near Lompoc, this Pinot Noir is subtle, enticing, and shows a powerful translucent redness in the glass. It carries a sage-y aromatic gauze, also showing site-typical scents of peat, cherries, citrus and exotic spice. The palate is full of minerals, cherry and strawberry, and shows a mouthwatering thread of plum skin. There's a great supple and gently salty mid-palate, then the smidge of whole clusters brings a fine spicy clench.
