


2018 CHARDONNAY SOLOMON HILLS SANTA MARIA VALLEY



This wine comes out swinging with the typical aromatic posse of pine, white flowers, and sea shell minerality. Those elements step into the background with air, as more concentrated fragrances of lemon curd and dried apple come forward, then more layers of chamomile and golden brioche really advance the wine's richness. This wine coats the mouth with fresh white stone fruit, savory pastry and stony minerals, while fine tannins pin down the wine's path as it makes broad curves across the palate.
