



2018 SYRAH

BIEN NACIDO

SANTA MARIA VALLEY

When we first started making Bien Nacido Syrah in 1994, the vineyard was a revelation for what we could do with cool-climate Syrah in California. Decades ago the conventional thought was that good Pinot Noir vineyards would be too cool to ripen the heartier Syrah grape, so most plantings were in warm locales that produced an indistinct (or distinctly Californian) expression of Syrah. Cool vineyards like Bien Nacido have a way of preserving the wild and spicy charms that you find in Syrah from the Northern Rhone, its homeland.

When you couple a cool site with a cool vintage like 2018, you see Syrah flaunting its pinnacle expression of savory, earthy complexity. The grapes for this wine were harvested in the third week of October. That gentle climb toward ideal ripeness lent loads of aromatic nuance. Upfront there's an intense nexus of smoky meat, iron and asphalt, then air brings out dark berries, violets and cardamom. The palate straddles brawn and elegance, with a rich and savory mid-palate balanced by mouthwatering acidity and strong peppery tannins. Those relent in the glass somewhat, but this Syrah will be best enjoyed with aging or a fatty lamb dish.
